Billing

Note that if your invoice amount for any month is small (less than about \$25), it will be deferred until it's larger to save us both the book work. And if your Hosting or domain comes due, I will automatically renew and bill you unless it's not obvious - then I will ask first. If you manage your own hosting or billing, I can't do that for you.

Backups

I have recently upgraded the backups I use. I now have a "Home Server" that uses Microsoft's new software of the same name. Each night it automatically makes a complete copy of the two computers in this house. For web sites, that gives four copies of the site files. The site copy, the host backup (perhaps up to 5 days old), the copy on my computer and the Home server backup copy. But it also backs-up anything you might have sent me in the last 24 hours.

Set-up email and get Statistics

To set-up emails and to access statistics on your site you need two things:

1. Your site access name and password – if you don't already have that, please email and I will send it to you.
